Friends International is a Christian charity seeking to grow friendship and faith with international students in the UK & Ireland, based in 35 different university cities. Sally is currently the Team Leader in Lancaster, based at the Lancaster University Chaplaincy Centre, and covering both Lancaster and Cumbria Universities. She is also the Cluster Leader for all FI groups in the North West of England. From January however she will be moving to join the Friends International team in Birmingham, working primarily with the city-centre institutions, including Aston and Birmingham City universities, where there are many overseas students.
